Mind the Gap

Transition from Primary to Post Primary Launch of Practical Workbook & Video By

The Minister for Mental Health & Older People, Helen McEntee, TD.

One of the transformational goals of the National Policy Framework "Better Outcomes Brighter Futures - The National Policy Framework for Children and Young People 2014-2020", is to support effective transitions. Children and young people experience a number of key transitions in their journey from childhood to adulthood including from primary school to post primary school.

Navan School Completion Programme (NSCP) Staff team developed a booklet called 'Transition Programme' delivered to 6th class students in the Spring of each year.

Its main aim is to assist young people successfully transfer from primary to secondary school. It encompasses exercises to help them negotiate teacher expectations, new environments and the journey from established social groups into new social relations.

When evaluated, the programme showed positive outcomes for the young people in NSCP Schools.

NSCP worked with Navan Springboard, LMETB and the Meath Children and Young Peoples Services Committee (CYPSC) with generous funding from Department of Children and Youth Affairs (DCYA), to redevelop and produce the booklet for use by all 5th and 6th class students in Meath.
