





GOING HAIRLESS FOR AWARENESS







C.A.P.S. is a charity that provides activities/events for children & young adults on the autism spectrum in Co. Cavan and surrounding areas. Activities include: Camps (Easter, Summer & Halloween), Social Clubs (Saturday & Computer), and much more...

C.A.P.S. also provides workshops for siblings and support meetings and training (as required) for parents. Including: Monthly Social Mornings for parents. These meetings are open to all parents not only members of C.A.P.S.



C.A.E.T.C. is a registered charity which was recently established to provide a full-time day service to young adults with a diagnosis of autism. The centre provides a four-year person-centred autism specific education and training service for young adults.

The C.A.E.T.C. CLG concept arose from the experiences, observations and aspirations of parents of young adults on the autism spectrum who have seen first-hand the need for autism specific adult day services. Service users will have improved life skills, greater independence and depending on ability, a QQI qualification with the hope of progressing to further education or employment.


