

FOREWORD



The North Central Child and Family Support Network was established in 2018 with the support of the Prevention, Partnership and Family Support Department in Tusla. It is one of five similar networks across the county. These networks bring together all Community and Statutory Services in a geographic area who work with children, young people and their families. In each network there are representatives from schools, youth services, health services, family support services, childcare services, the Gardai, Tusla, as well as many of the locally based community groups in the area.

The purpose of the network is to ensure that all members have a good understanding of the services that are available in their area to support children, young people and families. One of the main aims of establishing the Networks was to ensure that there is "no wrong door" when families go looking for support and this is achieved through each member's knowledge of the supports that are available from being part of the Network.

Many of the services in Networks are also trained in the Meitheal approach which is a supportive process for children and young people under 18 years who might be struggling either at home or at school. The Meitheal supports the parent and young person to identify what their needs are and puts supports in place around the family to meet these needs. Meitheals are available across Donegal.

This Directory will be a great resource to both the public and the services working in the North Central area of Donegal. Huge thanks to all who contributed and a special word of thanks to Donegal Local Development who have invested heavily through manpower and funding to put the Directory together.

INTRODUCTION

This Directory of Services has been put together by the North Central Child and Family Support Network. The Network covers Letterkenny Town and the surrounding towns and villages of Churchill, Kilmacrennan, Termon, Ramelton, Rathmullen, Milford, Kerrykeel, Portsalon, Glen, Cranford, Carrigart, Downings and Fanad. The aim of the Directory was to collate information about as many services as possible operating in this area that support families across the life course. We hope that if someone new comes to live in the North Central area the Directory will be able to direct them to all the supports and services they might need. As well as being a useful resource for families we also hope that the Directory will be seen as a useful resource for the many practitioners working in the community and aid them in sign posting young people and families to appropriate supports and services.

The Directory contains information on everything from the cradle to the grave, from family planning to care of the aged. Family Life is viewed across the entirety of the life course with services specific to children included whilst at the same time including adult specific services, for example Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services and Mental Health Services for Adults. We have included information on statutory services, community services and voluntary services. Whether you need information on your local Parent and Toddler Group, your local Public Health Nurse, places of worship, the Gardaí, childcare, local schools, adult education, youth supports, family supports, counselling services, disability services, or health and well being supports it can all be found in this publication.

There is alot of information out there online about what is available but sometimes this can be difficult to navigate. In this directory we have tried to pull alot of this information together into the one place to make it easier for a parent or practitioner working in the area. We have grouped all the projects, services and supports by theme with the themes presented alphabetically. Some organisations may appear several times depending on the range of services or programmes they offer. We have also included some national services that provide supports across the country, for example, AS I AM, AWARE, etc.

CHILDREN'S DISABILITY NETWORK TEAMS

As part of national changes Under 'Progressing Disability Services for Children & Young People', Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNT) have been set-up which aim to support children and young people with complex needs. CDNT's will encompass both Early Intervention Services (0-6 years) & School-Age Services (6-18years) and will become a service for children & young people with complex needs aged 0-18 years.

The CDNT is an interdisciplinary team who work collaboratively with the child and family to identify the needs and priorities of the child and family. From this process a written plan is developed over time, called an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP). This IFSP will include the goals chosen by the family and what strategies and supports are required to achieve these goals.

Reconfiguration to the new service is ongoing and families involved are being informed of the plans. Children & young people will remain with their current service until the reconfiguration is complete. During this period your service provider will be in contact with you to inform you of where your child will be transferring to following reconfiguration. They will assist you in terms of any queries you may have during this period.


