

Chime's Work with Services/Businesses

Chime is the National Charity for Deafness and Hearing loss. Chime works with children and adults who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing. Aside from our work with individuals/families, Chime champions for greater accessibility and opportunities for those impacted by deafness and hearing loss. Chime also works with services and businesses to promote the needs of those with hearing difficulties.

Chime can complete 'Deaf Awareness Training' with businesses to educate them on how to best meet the needs of those that are Deaf and Hard of Hearing.

Chime can provide support to services and businesses in ensuring that their premises is accessible for clients or staff members that are Deaf and Hard of Hearing. A Chime Staff member can do a physical assessment of a building to look at features such as access to the service i.e. text or email options rather than phone calls and loop systems where applicable. Chime can provide businesses with information on interpreting services for those who are Deaf and communicate using Irish Sign Language. Chime can also advise on technology in the workplace to support those with hearing loss i.e. adapted smoke alarms, door bells, phones and amplifying devices.
