New eLearning module

To support public bodies to understand and meet their obligations under the **Public Sector Equality and Human Rights Duty** set out in Section 42 of the Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission Act 2014.

Purpose of the eLearning

This eLearning module will support staff working in the public service to further their knowledge and understanding of **equality and human rights** and the statutory obligations within the **Public Sector Duty**.

Learning Outcomes -There are three units in the eLearning module.

- **Unit 1: Equality in the Public Service** – Introduces you to equality and the equality obligations of public bodies and explores issues facing staff and service users.
- **Unit 2: Human Rights in the Public Service** – Introduces you to human rights concepts and human rights obligations of public bodies and explores issues facing staff and service users.
- **Unit 3: The Public Sector Equality and Human Rights Duty** introduces you to the Public Sector Duty and the steps involved in its implementation

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Key features of the eLearning

- The eLearning is **free**.
- The module is **accessible** on a range of devices.
- It is **self-paced**, so you do not have to do it in one sitting.
- It will take approximately three hours to complete.
- There is an assessment at the end of each unit, which you must pass to proceed.
