We asked Dublin City Young People, aged 12-17 years, how Covid-19 has impacted their lives. The research was carried out by Dublin City North and Dublin City South Children and Young People's Services Committees (CYPSC), with Dublin City Comhairle na nÓg. In total, 218 Young People answered an online survey in July/August 2020, and 10 Young People from Dublin City Comhairle na nÓg took part in an online focus group.

HERE'S WHAT YOUNG PEOPLE SAID:

1. HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Mixed Feelings Since Covid-19 (some or most of the time)

91% feel SAD

73% feel NERVOUS

73% feel LONELY

96% feel HAPPY
