# Stats in Ireland: What we know

40% of children reported to being online for over 4 hours a day during lockdown, whereas 0% said this happened prior to lockdown. (Barnardos, 2020 report)

13% of secondary school students have sent a nude or a semi nude photo of themselves to others (Zeeko, 2018 report)

53% of boys in Ireland first watched pornography under the age of 13.
(SMART consent report 2018)

A link between those who spent more than 3 hours a day online and a higher rate of **depression** and a lower rate of body selfesteem (My world survey, Jigsaw 2019)

8% of 10-16 year olds say they have cyberbullied others. 16% have said they have been cyberbullied.

(HSBC Health Behaviour in School Age Children, 2018)




Family guide with fun activities for parents and children

Set daily screen time limits


Set a device bedtime

Set per app time limits


Grant bonus screen time

SafeSearch helps to filter explicit content out of search results.

When SafeSearch is on, it helps block explicit images, videos, and websites from Google Search results.




