Services Provided

Offers up to 8 sessions of brief intervention therapeutic support to young people (12-25 years) who are experiencing mild to moderate mental health difficulties. Face to face, online and phone support options.

How to access service

Young people and their families can contact us directly. Under 18's require parental consent. Referrals can be made by a professional but are not necessary.

The Listen Project provides a specialist 1-2-1 support service, for up to 9 sessions. Face to face, online and phone options.

How to access service

Young people can self-refer, or be referred by family member, friend, health/ education/ welfare professional. Parent/carer consent for under 18's, and young person must be willing to participate.
