SERVICES WE PROVIDE AT D15 COMMUNITY ADDICTION TEAM



Stabilisation Programme

- > Adults 18+ who are impacted by drug and alcohol misuse
- 2 groups per week at 1.5 hours per group.
- Clients enrolled in the programme are also keyworked on a weekly/bi-weekly basis



Alcohol Programme

- Our alcohol programme runs 3 mornings per week, Monday, Wednesday and Friday for a duration of 2 hours.
- > This is a 20 week day programme.
- Similar to the stabilisation programme, clients are keyworked on a weekly/bi-weekly basis.
- Once clients have completed their programme they are eligible to then move onto our aftercare programme which runs once per week for a minimum of 5 months.



Young Persons Programme

- Our young persons group is aimed at 16-24yr olds.
- > This runs twice per week for a duration of 1.5 hours.
- This is run as a Reduce the Use programme.
- Young people are keyworked weekly and/or bi-weekly.



Cocaine Programme

- Cocaine Programme is based on the Resonance Factor and runs twice per week for a duration of 1.5 hours.
- The cocaine programme is a 12 week closed group and takes place in the evenings.
- Specifically for adults who are struggling with their cocaine use.
- Clients are also keyworked on a weekly/bi-weekly basis.



Parents Under Pressure

- Our Parents under Pressure programme is designed to help parents build and maintain healthy and nurturing relationships with their children.
- This programme is carried out either within a group setting or on a one to one weekly session.



Family Support Programme

- Our family support is a facilitated weekly open group that runs once per week for a duration of 1.5 hours.
- ➤ This is for family members only who have been impacted by addiction.
- ➤ The aim of family support is healing and recovery for family members from the destruction of addiction.
