What Is Family Support?

- The collective title given to a broad range of provisions developed by a combination of statutory and voluntary agencies to promote the welfare of children and families in their own homes and communities"
- Partnership approach.
- Family Support intervention needs lead, minimum interaction required.
- Family support focuses on the wishes, feelings and safety of children/families.
- ► Family support reflects a strengths-based perspective which is mindful of resilience within families.
- Family Support interventions aim to strengthen informal support networks.
