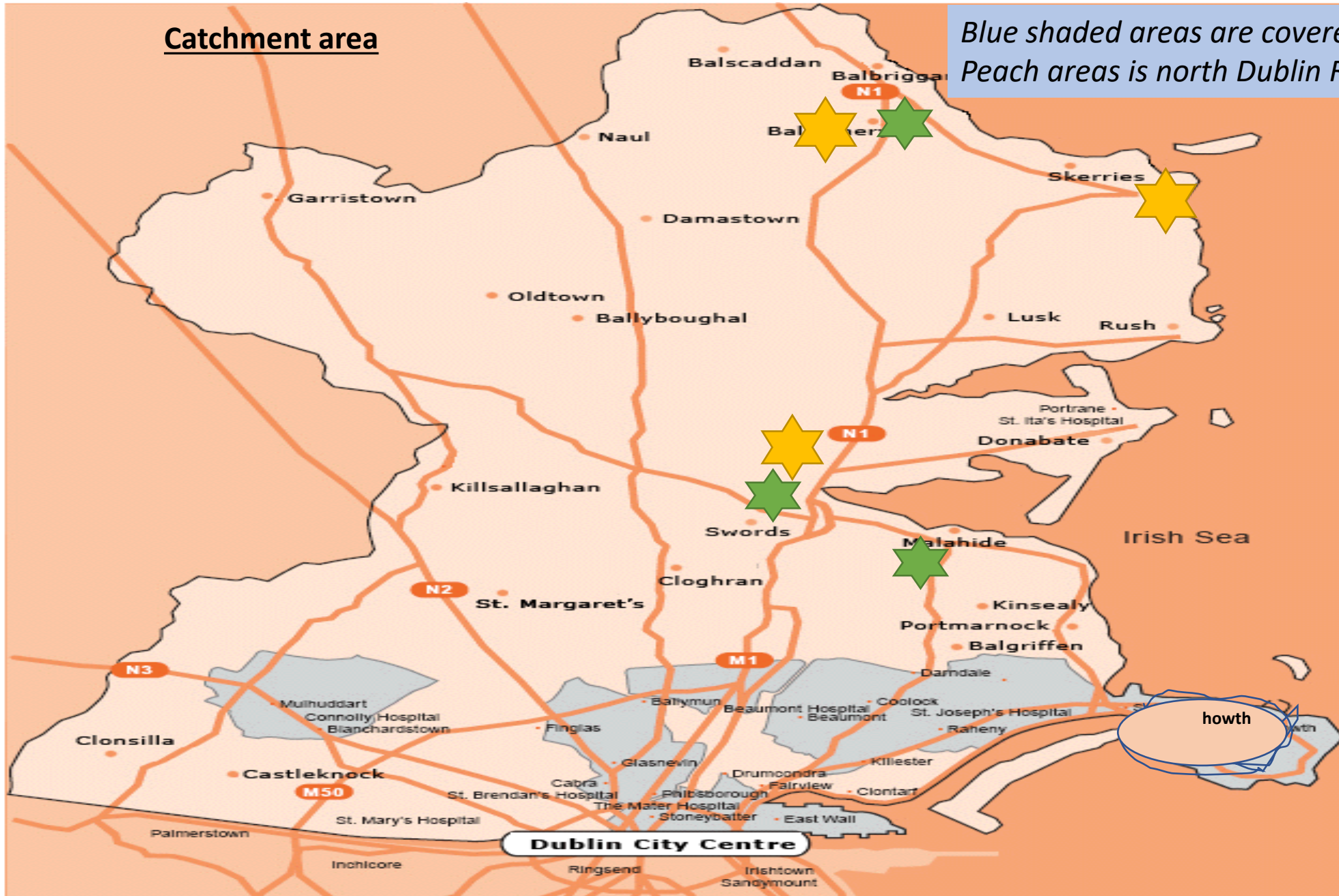

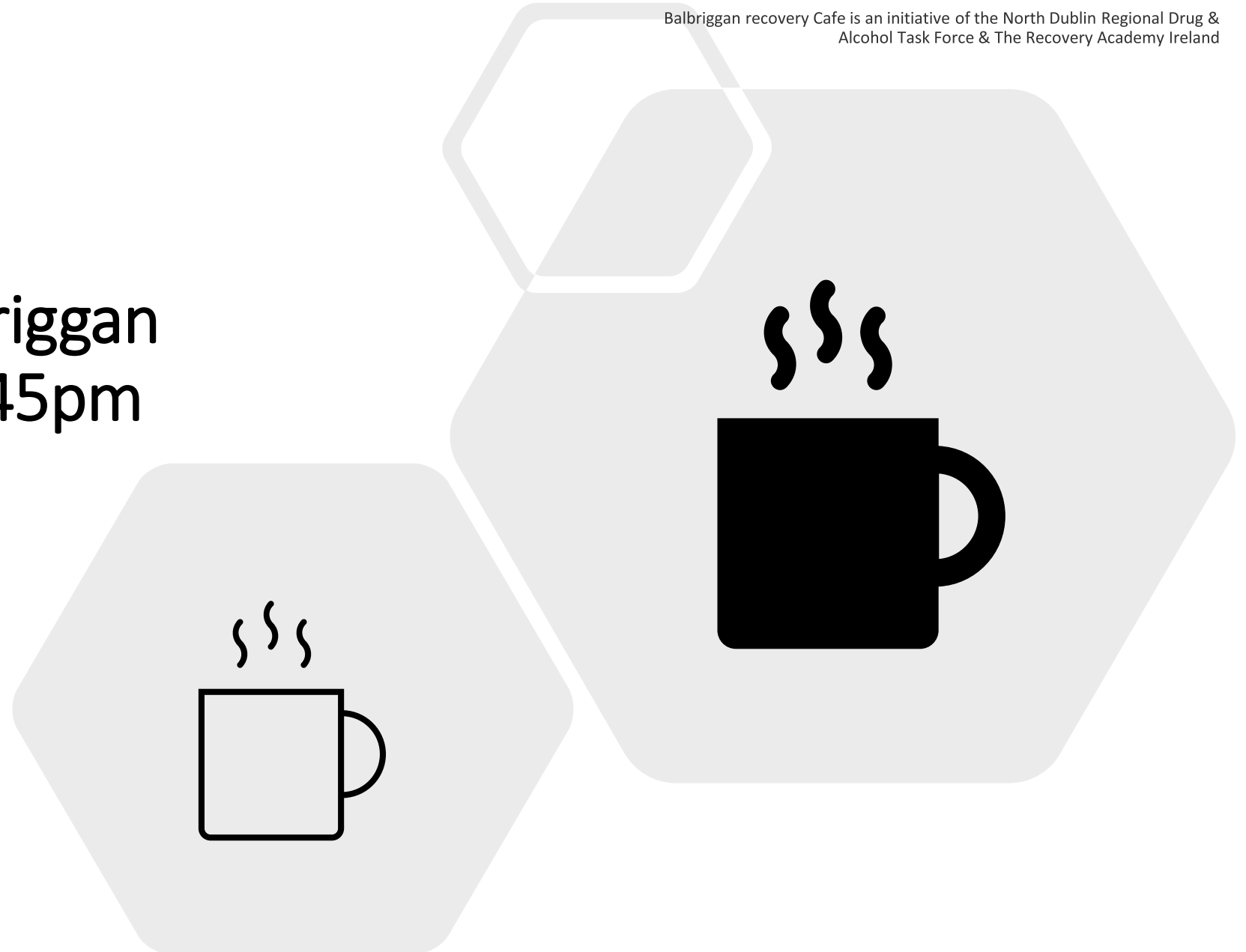
- **Core client group- Consists of individuals seeking support for a substance misuse issue & associated family support services. 18+**

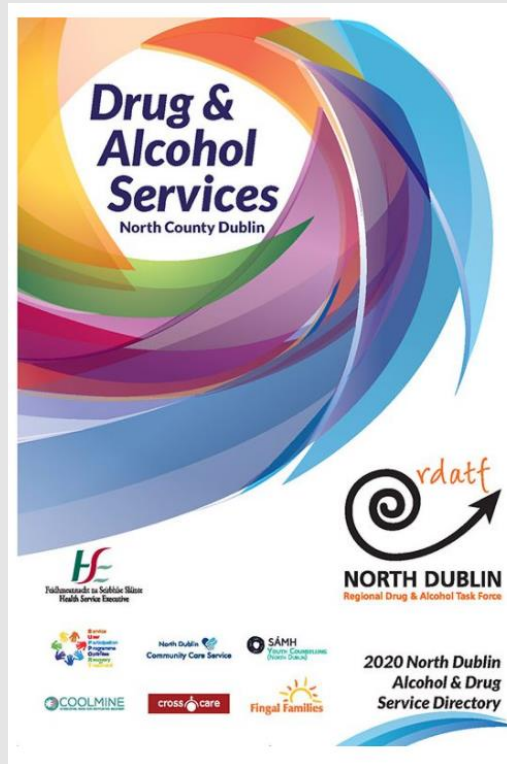
