



Pieta – about us!

- ▶ Pieta first opened its doors in Lucan, County Dublin in 2006. Since then we have seen and helped over 58,000 people in suicidal distress or engaging in self-harm.
- ▶ We now operate fifteen centres and five outreach service across Ireland. Pieta now employs over 200 therapists and administration staff, and the demand for our service is increasing.
- ▶ Everything is free of charge and our staff are fully qualified, providing a professional one-to-one therapeutic service for people who are experiencing suicidal ideation, people who have attempted suicide and people who are engaging in self-harm. A doctor's referral or a psychiatric report is not required.

These are awareness driven initiatives to instil and empower young people with coping mechanisms to prevent them potentially incurring suicidal or self-harm thoughts in the future.

- 'Holdover' Appointments



Suicide Bereavement Liaison service

- ▶ 12 SBL- Officers (SBLOs)
- From 48hrs after a death by suicide –and Up to 8 weeks after a death by suicide
- Face to Face / Phone support available
- 8 support Sessions
- Communities & Homes
- Signposting & Information

Bereavement Therapy

- 3 months after a death by Suicide
- Adults (30 Sessions)
- U18 (20 Sessions) U12 (15 Sessions)
- ► Face to Face Therapy available in 20 Locations
- Phone & Video Therapy
