- ➤ Facilitating a free and confidential early intervention youth counselling service




Organisation – Who we are

- Established in 2016
- Community based organisation Run by the Community for the Community
- Currently 14 Committee Members all volunteers
- Charitable Status obtained in 2020



Information Booklet



- First edition launched in 2016
- Given to all students of local secondary schools (Skerries, Donabate, Balbriggan etc.)
- Delivered to majority of houses in Skerries
- Available in local shops, train station, community centre, doctors etc.
- Currently on fourth edition approx. 6,000 in circulation



Information Sessions

- Several information talks held in collaboration with other service providers
 - North Dublin Regional Drug and Alcohol Task Force, Jigsaw etc.
- Aimed at both parents and young people
- Examples: "Talking to a Young Person about Alcohol and other Drugs" &
 "Parenting the Rewards and challenges" with John Lonergan
- Working in conjunction with local community groups scouts, schools, sports clubs





SYSS



Any young person aged between 12-24 who is experiencing challenges to their mental health can avail of free counselling at Skerries Youth Support Services, there is no referral needed. Please call <u>089 616 7222</u> to arrange an appointment.





- 2017 One day a week service funded by the North Dublin Regional Drug and Alcohol Task Force (NDRDATF)
- 2018 SYSS and the NDRDATF become partners in funding one day a week each
- 2020 SYSS fund a third day
- 2021 SYSS fund a fourth day
- 2022 SYSS fund a fifth day to alleviate waiting list
- Flexibility to increase / decrease the provision of the service based on demand



- Early intervention counselling.
- Professional (fully insured and accredited) youth counsellors to provide the service.
- Fully funded no cost to the service user.
- 6-8 sessions per service user.
- Presenting issues: anxiety, depression, stress, body image etc.
- Appointments available five days per week (including weekends)



- Service available to young people aged between 12 and 24 either living in, going to school or working in Skerries and the surrounding areas.
- Multiple referral sources self, parent / family, school, GP etc.
- Up to 25 young people seen every week.
- Over 185 young people supported over the last 12 months.



Funding

- SYSS services are provided through fundraising
- One day per week funded by the North Dublin Regional Drug and Alcohol Task Force and one day per week by Hamilton Park Care Facility
- No State funding is received


